

8th Annual Midsummer Pageant & Workshop In Morinesio, Italy June 20 – 28, 2009

The workshop starts on Saturday June 20th and ends on Sunday June 28th.
For arrivals from abroad we suggest to arrive no later than Friday June 19th, 2009 in Morinesio.

<u>Price options:</u>	per person
1. Single room with private bathroom at Casa dei Fiori	2,180 Euro
2. Double occupancy apartment (2 rooms) with bathroom at Casa dei Fiori	1,980 Euro
3. Double occupancy room (2 beds) with bathroom in next door B&B	1,880 Euro
4. Dormitory like accommodation with shared bathroom (max 3 per room) In 7 minutes walking distance	1,750 Euro
5. Student rate in dorm like accommodation as under 4 for a fixed price without discount options.	1.480 Euro

For workshop attendees bringing their spouse/partner which is not planning to attend the workshop itself, the fee for the duration of the workshop including full board of meals will be 1,050 Euros as long as double rooms/apartments are available

Enrollments prior to January 1st, 2009 qualify for an early bird discount of **15%**
Enrollments prior to March 1st 2009 qualify for an early bird discount of **5%**

The workshop fee includes:

Taxi transfer from/to Cuneo train station to Morinesio.

During the stay we provide breakfast, lunch and dinner including beverages (also wine).

For attendees wanting to arrive earlier or extend their stay for additional days to learn some more about the beautiful Valle Maira and the surrounding Piedmont region, we'll try to accommodate that as well on request.

Enrollment & payment information:

For the enrollment to the workshop a **deposit of 750 Euro** (or the US \$ equivalent of about 1,000US\$) is required. The minimum number of participants is 12. In case of less than 12 enrolled participants by May 1, 2009 the workshop can be cancelled and the full deposit will be refunded.

Cancellations by participants after May 1, 2009 will not get a refund of the deposit.

We do not accept credit cards. Payments can be made in cash, traveler checks or via checks in US\$.

European participants can transfer the deposit directly to our bank account.

We suggest to get a travel insurance to avoid any loss of deposit payments.
